- 1. Explain the most interesting thing you learned from reading this book and explain why it stood out for you. Be specific and be sure to reference the text.
- 2. Explain three NEW things that you learned while reading this text.
- 3. What is your opinion on the topic that you read about? How do you feel about some of the issues that were presented in your book?
- 4. After reading the text, what are two questions that you have that you would want to know more about?

In fiction, such as myths, novels, and short stories, the subject matter is imaginary. In nonfiction, the subject matter is factual. The writer of nonfiction writes about actual people, places, and things.

Along with your written assignment, please create a poster for the topic that is discussed in the book that you chose to read. Your poster should include at least 4 visuals and 4 facts about your topic.

Note: Your summer reading assignment must have a cover page in which you include the title and author of the book as well as your name. The response to each question should be a minimum of one paragraph (5-7 sentences in length. BE SPECIFIC and be sure to reference the text. Please type or NEATLY handwrite your assignment. Your summer assignment and poster will be collected on the first day of school.
